The Families NSW Culturally and Linguistically Diverse (CALD) Community Facilitator Project has been extended into the Ryde/Hunters Hill Local Government Areas to support consultations with members of Afghan, Iranian, Chinese and Korean communities, in order to help parents in those communities to access relevant government and community services.

MigrantLINK is currently recruiting two Community Facilitators from the Afghan community, who will work on a casual basis with MigrantLINK in organizing consultations with specific organizations to identify the community's needs for their services, and barriers to accessing them.

Time spent in training, and working on developing consultations will be paid for at an hourly rate.
